FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act requiring education in the history and contributions of Asian Americans and
- 2 Pacific Islanders."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to article 10 to read:
- 5 Sec. 14.30.430. Education in history and contributions of Asian Americans
- and Pacific Islanders. (a) Each school district shall establish and provide to students
- 7 in kindergarten through grade 12 a program, approved by the department, that includes
- 8 (1) instruction on the history of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders
- and contributions made by Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders in the United States;
- 10 and
- 11 (2) instructional materials that portray the cultural and economic
- diversity of Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders.
- (b) In this section, "school district" has the meaning given in AS 14.30.350.
