# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

# 1 "An Act relating to testing of sexual assault examination kits; and providing for an

2 effective date."

# **3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 44.41.065(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) When a law enforcement agency collects a sexual assault examination kit 6 under AS 18.68.010, the agency shall

(1) within 30 days after the agency collects the sexual assault
examination kit, send the sexual assault examination kit to an accredited laboratory in
coordination with the Department of Public Safety or a laboratory operated by the
Department of Public Safety;

(2) ensure that the laboratory to which the sexual assault examination
kit is sent under (1) of this subsection conducts a serological or DNA test on the
sexual assault examination kit within <u>six months</u> [ONE YEAR] after the laboratory
receives the sexual assault examination kit; and

1 (3) within two weeks after the laboratory that receives the sexual 2 assault examination kit under (1) of this subsection completes serological or DNA 3 testing, make a reasonable effort to notify the victim from whom the sexual assault 4 examination kit was collected that the sexual assault examination kit has been tested.
