FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to business license fees; and providing for an effective date."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 * **Section 1.** AS 43.70.030(a) is amended to read:
- 4 (a) The fee for each business license is **§100** [\$50] a year, except that the fee is
- 5 <u>\$50</u> [\$25] if the business is a sole proprietorship and the sole proprietor is
- 6 (1) 65 years of age or older when the sole proprietor applies for the
- 7 license or will reach 65 years of age at any time during the year for which the license
- 8 is issued; or
- 9 (2) a disabled veteran.
- * **Sec. 2.** AS 43.70.075(b) is amended to read:
- 11 (b) The department, upon payment of a fee of \$200 [\$100], shall issue a
- business license endorsement to a person who applies for a business license under this
- chapter, and may renew the endorsement issued under this subsection for a fee of \$200
- [\$100]. The endorsement expires at the same time as the license to which it attaches.
- Upon issuance of an endorsement, the department shall also issue to the person

- 1 receiving the endorsement notice of the penalties that may be imposed under this
- 2 section.
- 3 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect October 1, 2024.
