- 1 "An Act relating to permitting a dog or domestic animal to enter or remain on private
- 2 property without authorization."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 03.55 is amended by adding new sections to read:
- 5 Article 3. Control of Animals.
- Sec. 03.55.200. Failure to control animal. (a) The owner and the person having custody and control of a dog or domestic animal may not permit the dog or domestic animal to enter or remain on private property outside a controlled livestock district under AS 03.35.010 03.35.070 without authorization.
- 10 (b) Permitting a dog or domestic animal to enter or remain on private property without authorization is a violation.
- Sec. 03.55.290. Definitions. In AS 03.55.200 03.55.290, "domestic animal" has the meaning given in AS 03.35.070.
