A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act allowing a person who retires as a peace officer or firefighter under the defined
2 benefit plan of the public employees' retirement system to receive credited service in the
3 plan for up to five years of past military service; and providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 39.35.340(d) is amended to read:

6 (d) Subject to (j) of this section, the [THE] credited service granted under
7 this section may not be used to satisfy the credited service requirements for normal
8 retirement.

9 * **Sec. 2.** AS 39.35.340 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (j) Notwithstanding (d) of this section, credited service granted under this
11 section to a person who retires as a peace officer or firefighter

12 (1) is service as a peace officer or firefighter under AS 39.35.370; and

13 (2) may be used to satisfy the credited service requirements for normal
14 retirement.

1 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
