A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act making a special appropriation to the Department of Military and Veterans'
- 2 Affairs to hire a consulting firm to develop strategies for retention of military
- 3 installations affected by the next base realignment and closure announcement; and
- 4 providing for an effective date."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department
- 7 of Military and Veterans' Affairs to hire a consulting firm to address the current budget
- 8 reduction efforts by the United States Department of Defense and to develop strategies for
- 9 retention of military installations affected by future base realignment and closure
- announcements, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2012, and June 30, 2013.
- * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
