A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the appointment of an assistant adjutant general; and providing for**
2 **an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 26.05.180(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) The headquarters of the Alaska National Guard is composed of an Army
6 National Guard component, an Air National Guard component, and a Naval Militia
7 component. The Army National Guard component and the Air National Guard
8 component shall each be commanded by an assistant adjutant general appointed by the
9 adjutant general with the concurrence of the governor. **The adjutant general may,**
10 **when appointing an assistant adjutant general, give preference to a person who**
11 **has served at least five years in the Alaska Army National Guard or the Alaska**
12 **Air National Guard.** An assistant adjutant general shall, while holding office, have
13 the grade of brigadier general or a lower grade that the adjutant general may prescribe.
14 On initial appointment, an assistant adjutant general must hold a **federally recognized**

1 [FEDERALLY-RECOGNIZED] field-grade commission [WITH AT LEAST FIVE
2 YEARS SERVICE IN THE ALASKA ARMY NATIONAL GUARD OR IN THE
3 ALASKA AIR NATIONAL GUARD].

4 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
