3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 47.07.036 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
 - (h) Notwithstanding (a) (c) of this section, and in addition to the projects and services described under (d) (f) of this section, the department may apply for a section 1115 waiver under 42 U.S.C. 1315(a) to establish one or more demonstration projects focused on addressing health-related needs and supportive services for one or more groups of medical assistance recipients in one or more specific geographic areas. In this subsection, "health-related needs" means social or economic conditions that contribute to an individual's poor health outcomes and may include nutrition and food security, workforce development, transportation, temporary housing, or case management.
