A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to medical review organizations; relating to the definitions of 'health

2 care provider' and 'review organization'; and relating to the duties of the chief medical

3 officer in the Department of Health."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

5 *** Section 1.** AS 18.23.030(a) is amended to read:

6 Except as provided in (b), (c), and (e) of this section, all data and (a) 7 information acquired by a review organization in the exercise of its duties and 8 functions shall be held in confidence and may not be disclosed to anyone except to the 9 extent necessary to carry out the purposes of the review organization and is not subject 10 to subpoena or discovery. Except as provided in (b) of this section, a person described 11 in AS 18.23.020 may not disclose what transpired at a meeting of a review 12 organization except to the extent necessary to carry out the purposes of a review 13 organization, and the proceedings and records of a review organization are not subject 14 to discovery or introduction into evidence in a civil action against a health care

1	provider arising out of the matter that is the subject of consideration by the review
2	organization. Information, documents, or records otherwise available from original
3	sources are not immune from discovery or use in a civil action merely because they
4	were presented during proceedings of a review organization, nor may a person who
5	testified before a review organization or who is a member of it be prevented from
6	testifying as to matters within the person's knowledge, but a witness may not be asked
7	about the witness's testimony before a review organization or opinions formed by the
8	witness as a result of its hearings, except as provided in (b) of this section.

10	(e) A review organization may publish a report containing data or information
11	obtained in the exercise of its duties if the report does not violate federal or state law
12	regarding confidentiality of a person or decedent. A report may include
13	(1) the identification of trends, patterns, and risk factors;
14	(2) an analysis of the rate and cause of death in the state; and
15	(3) methods of intervention or prevention related to causes of death.

13	mortality [; AT LEAST 75 PERCENT OF THE COMMITTEE MEMBERS
14	MUST BE HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS];
15	(D) a nationally recognized group or entity that accredits
16	health care organizations, including the Joint Commission on Accreditation
17	of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO).
