FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to immunity of persons who provide surveillance videos to law
- 2 enforcement agencies for law enforcement purposes."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 09.65.340. Civil liability for providing surveillance video to law enforcement. A person who conducts, as a security measure, video surveillance of the person's property is not liable for civil damages if the person, without a search warrant, allows a law enforcement officer to view that video or provides a copy of the video to a law enforcement officer if the law enforcement officer requests the video to assist with a criminal prosecution or to determine if a crime has been committed.
