3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 14.08.061(c) is repealed and reenacted to read:
 - (c) The voters residing within a regional educational attendance area may propose imposing term limits on the regional school board members by petition. A petition under this subsection must be filed with the director of elections and must contain signatures of qualified voters in the area equal to eight percent of the total votes cast in the most recent regional school board election. The imposition of term limits on regional school board members is subject to approval by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the question in the regional educational attendance area at the next regular school board election, or a special election called for that purpose, and takes effect at the next regular regional school board election.
