5	* Section 1. AS 23.15.220 is amended to read:
6	Sec. 23.15.220. Purpose. The purpose of AS 23.15.220 - 23.15.320 is to create
7	a State Vocational Rehabilitation Committee [GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON
8	EMPLOYMENT OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES] for Alaska to carry on a
9	continuing program to promote the employment of people of the state with disabilities
10	by creating statewide interest in the rehabilitation and employment of people with
11	disabilities, and by obtaining and maintaining cooperation with public and private
12	groups and individuals in this field.
13	* Sec. 2. AS 23.15.230 is amended to read:

Sec. 23.15.230. Appointment of committee. The governor shall appoint the

1	members of the State Vocational Rehabilitation Committee [GOVERNOR'S
2	COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF NOT MORE THAN 12 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY
3	THE GOVERNOR] for staggered terms not exceeding three years. The composition
4	of the committee must be consistent with the requirements of 29 U.S.C. 725 and
5	3003, as amended [THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMPOSED OF STATE
6	LEADERS OF INDUSTRY, BUSINESS, AGRICULTURE, LABOR, VETERANS,
7	WOMEN, RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, CIVIC, FRATERNAL, WELFARE,
8	SCIENTIFIC, MILITARY, MEDICAL, AND OTHER PROFESSIONS, OR AS
9	MANY OF THESE AND LIKE CATEGORIES AS MAY BE FEASIBLY
10	REPRESENTED]. A member may be reappointed, and a vacancy shall be filled by the
11	governor.

- Sec. 23.15.240. <u>Selection</u> [APPOINTMENT] and term of chair. The members of the committee shall select a chair from among the voting members of the committee, subject to disapproval by the governor. The chair serves [GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE WHO SERVES AS CHAIR] for one year or until a successor is <u>selected</u> [APPOINTED].
- * **Sec. 4.** AS 23.15.260 is amended to read:
- Sec. 23.15.260. Meetings. The committee shall meet <u>four times a year</u>

 [ANNUALLY], but, at the request of the governor, special meetings may be called.

- TRANSITION: MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON

 Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities on the day before the effective date of
- 27 this Act continues to serve as a member of the State Vocational Rehabilitation Committee,
- created by AS 23.15.220, as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, if the Department of Labor and
- 29 Workforce Development finds that the member meets the eligibility requirements under
- 30 AS 23.15.230, as amended by sec. 2 of this Act. A member who continues service under this
- 31 section after the effective date of this Act

1 (1) serves until the member's term would have expired as a member of the

- 2 Governor's Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities; and
- 3 (2) may apply to the governor for reappointment to the State Vocational
- 4 Rehabilitation Committee after the member's term expires.

- 7 REVISOR'S INSTRUCTION. The revisor of statutes shall change the heading of art.
