A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska prohibiting the
- 2 imposition of a broad-based individual income tax or statewide general sales tax without
- 3 the approval of the voters of the state.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. Article IX, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:
- **Section 1. Taxing Power.** The power of taxation shall never be surrendered.
- 7 This power shall not be suspended or contracted away, except as provided in this
- 8 article. A law establishing a broad-based individual income tax or a statewide
- 9 general sales tax shall not take effect until approved by the voters of the State by
- a majority of the votes cast on the proposed law.
- * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the
- state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State
- of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
