13 Relating to Mobile County; to prohibit the Mobile
14 County Health Department from regulating any intermittent food
15 service establishment that prepares food in association with a
16 regional celebration or tradition if the food service
17 establishment does not prepare, sell, or distribute food on a
18 regular basis or in its regular line of business.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act,
21 intermittent food service establishment shall mean any entity
22 that has a physical address within Mobile County that does not
23 prepare or serve food in its regular line of business but
24 prepares and serves food on an intermittent basis for a period
25 of time not to exceed three days per week, at a single,
26 specified or designated location in conjunction with a

1 recurring event such as a local or regional celebration,
2 tradition, custom, or cultural event.

3 (b) An intermittent food service establishment shall
4 complete an online application on the Mobile County Public
5 Health website, at no charge, two business days before the
6 event for an exemption of food service at a temporary food
7 event. The operator of the temporary food event shall have
8 knowledge of the proper temperature for food service, have a
9 handwashing facility, and plan for adequate garbage
10 containment.

11 (c) Other than subsection (b), the Mobile County
12 Health Department shall not regulate an intermittent food
13 service establishment that prepares food in association with a
14 regional celebration or tradition when the establishment does
15 not prepare, sell, or distribute food on a regular basis or in
16 its regular line of business.

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
