| 10 | disabled or deceased veteran or otherwise eligible for |

| 12 | attend and attends a comprehensive transition and |
| 13 | postsecondary program for students with intellectual |

| 15 | be eligible to receive benefits equal to the benefits provided |
| 16 | pursuant to this chapter, to any other child eligible for |
