Section 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this amendatory act shall become operative only if approved by the majority of the qualified electors of Elmore County who vote in an election to be held on the day designated by the Judge of Probate of Elmore County. The notice of the election shall be given by the judge of probate, which notice shall be published once a week for three successive weeks before the day of the election, and the election shall be held, conducted, and the results canvassed in the manner as other county elections. The election shall be held in conjunction with the next regularly schedule state or local election to be held in the county. The question shall be, "Do you favor the adoption of Act No.____, of the 2023 Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature which provides for the appointment of the county superintendent of education and the repeal of Act 258

25 of the 1931 Regular Session, relating to the election
26 of the county superintendent of education? Yes () No
27 (). The county shall pay any costs and expenses not
28 otherwise incidental to the election. If a majority of
29 the votes cast in the election are "Yes," the
30 amendatory language of Sections 1 and 2 of this act
