This act shall not apply to any municipal 4 5 utilities board operating a cable television system. Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 6 7 with this act are repealed. Section 4. This act shall become effective on the 8 9 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
