Relating to physicians and osteopaths; to provide for the limited waiver of licensing requirements for athletic team physicians when traveling in this state with their team for the purposes of a sporting event.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Subject to subsection (b), the licensing requirements of Chapter 24, Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, do not apply to any person who holds a current unrestricted license to practice medicine or osteopathy in another state when the person, pursuant to a written agreement with an athletic team located in that state provides medical services to any of the following while the team is traveling to or from or participating in a sporting event in this state: services to any member of the official traveling party.

- (1) A member of the athletic team.
- (2) A member of the coaching, communications, equipment, or sports medicine staff of the athletic team.
- (3) A member of the band or cheerleading squad accompanying the athletic team.
 - (4) The mascot for the athletic team.
 - (b) In providing medical services pursuant to subsection (a), the person may not provide medical services at a health care facility including, but not limited to, a
