ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to physicians and osteopaths; to provide for the limited waiver of licensing requirements for athletic team physicians when traveling in this state with their team for the purposes of a sporting event.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Subject to subsection (b), the licensing requirements of Chapter 24, Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, do not apply to any person who holds a current unrestricted license to practice medicine or osteopathy in another state when the person, pursuant to a written agreement with an athletic team located in that state provides medical ~~services to any of the following while the team is traveling to or from or participating in a sporting event in this state:~~ services to any member of the official traveling party.

~~(1) A member of the athletic team.~~

~~(2) A member of the coaching, communications, equipment, or sports medicine staff of the athletic team.~~

~~(3) A member of the band or cheerleading squad accompanying the athletic team.~~

~~(4) The mascot for the athletic team.~~

(b) In providing medical services pursuant to subsection (a), the person may not provide medical services at a health care facility including, but not limited to, a

1 hospital, an ambulatory surgical facility, or any other  
2 facility in which medical care, diagnosis, or treatment is  
3 provided on an inpatient or outpatient basis.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
5 first day of the third month following its passage and  
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
