13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 4 of Act 85-435, 1985 Regular
15	Session (Acts 1985, p. 403), as last amended by Act 2023-82,
16	2023 Regular Session, is amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 4. (a) Except as hereinafter provided, the
18	judge of probate shall be entitled to charge and collect the
19	same fees that are provided for by law. For the performance of
20	duties relative to the recording of the transfer of the
21	ownership of motor vehicles as prescribed in the Code of
22	Alabama 1975 In addition to all other charges, assessments, and
23	fees for license tags, the judge of probate shall charge and
24	collect a fee of one dollar (\$1) for the issuance of all
25	license tags. All such fees shall be the property of the
26	county and shall be paid to the general fund of the county.
27	Refunds for licenses issued by mistake or fact of law shall be
28	made under the conditions and in the manner prescribed by the

- 30 (b) Commencing on the effective date of the act adding
- 31 this subsection, the judge of probate shall charge and collect
- 32 a fee of two dollars (\$2) for the issuance of all license
- tags. This fee shall be in addition to all other charges,

- in the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund to be used for law
