13 Relating to Limestone County; to amend Section 1 of
14 Act 2006-343 of the 2006 Regular Session (Acts 2006, p. 914)
15 now appearing as Section 45-2-201.01, Code of Alabama 1975;
16 providing further for the financing of the budgetary
17 operations of the revenue commissioner and the license
18 commissioner on a pro rata share basis from proceeds of state,
19 county, and municipal ad valorem taxes collected in the
20 county; and to provide for retroactive effect.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2006-343 of the 2006
23 Regular Session (Acts 2006, p. 914), now appearing as Section
24 45-2-201.01, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as
25 follows:

26 "Section 1. The Revenue Commissioner and License
27 Commissioner of Limestone County, respectively, shall each be

1 responsible for the budgetary operations and functions of his
2 or her office. The expenses of each office shall be financed
3 on a pro rata share basis from the proceeds of any state,
4 county, and municipal ad valorem taxes collected in the county
5 ~~in the same manner as the salary of the tax assessor or tax~~
6 ~~collector is paid pursuant to Section 40-6A-2, Code of Alabama~~
7 ~~1975.~~ Any funds retained pursuant to this act shall be used
8 solely for the operation of each office, respectively, subject
9 to approval of the budget for the office by the county
10 commission in the same manner as the budget is currently
11 approved."

12 Section 2. This amendatory act is remedial and
13 curative and shall be retroactive to April 12, 2006.

14 Section 3. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
