Any funds retained pursuant to this act shall be used solely for the operation of each office, respectively, subject 8 to approval of the budget for the office by the county 9 10 commission in the same manner as the budget is currently approved." 11 Section 2. This amendatory act is remedial and 12 13 curative and shall be retroactive to April 12, 2006. 14 Section 3. This act shall become effective 15 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 16
