To amend Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the escape of inmates; to require notification of certain state and local agencies and the news media when an inmate escapes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975, is 9 amended to read as follows:

10 "§14-3-58.

11 "(a) This section shall be known as the "Joel

12 <u>Willmore Act."</u>

13 "(b) Whenever any convict an inmate escapes from a 14 penal facility, of the Department of Corrections as defined in 15 subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of Section 13A-10-30, it 16 shall be the duty of the Board of Corrections department or 17 other agency having custody of a prisoner to take all proper 18 measures for his or her apprehension, and for that purpose, it 19 must forthwith shall notify the following as soon as possible, but not later than 12 hours after the escape: 20

21 "<u>(1)</u> communicate to the Governor the fact of such
 22 escape, The Governor.

 "(3) The sheriff and district attorney of the county
 where the escape occurred.

"(4) The chief of police where the escape occurred, 1 if the escape occurred within a municipality. 2 "(5) The sheriff and district attorney of the county 3 where the last conviction of the escapee occurred, if known. 4 5 "(6) The chief of police where the last conviction of the escapee occurred, if the conviction occurred within a 6 7 municipality and if known. 8 "(7) The sheriff of the county where the convict's home of record is located, if known. 9 10 "(8) The chief of police where the convict's home of 11 record is located, if the location is within a municipality 12 and if known. 13 "(9) All electronic media outlets broadcasting which are known by the department or agency, which have expressed an 14 15 interest in being notified of the escape, and which broadcast 16 within a radius of 75 miles from where the escape occurred, 17 including all radio and television stations. 18 "(c) The notification required in subsection (b) 19 shall include the time when and the circumstances under which it the escape was effected, together with a particular 20 description of the convict inmate, including a copy of the 21 22 inmate's most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted 23 and for what offense and when; "(d) In addition to the requirements set forth in 24 subsections (b) and (c), the department or other agency shall 25

1	post a notification on its website, if a website is available,
2	within a reasonable time of the escape. The notification shall
3	include the time when and the circumstances under which the

8	"(e) The department or other agency shall enter the
9	inmate into the National Crime Information Center within 12

14	inmate, to be paid out of the proceeds of the labor of

23	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
