2 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Alabama Interagency Council 3 4 for the Prevention of Elder Abuse with certain modifications; to amend Section 38-9D-3, Code of Alabama 1975, so as to 5 provide that the council shall meet at the call of the chair 6 7 and to repeal Section 38-9D-7, Code of Alabama 1975, to remove the council from regularly scheduled review under the Sunset 8 9 Law.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the sunset committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama Interagency Council for the Prevention of Elder Abuse, with the additional recommendations for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama Interagency Council for the Prevention of Elder Abuse, created and functioning pursuant to Sections 38-9D-1 to 38-9D-7, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and Sections 38-9D-1 to 38-9D-6, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, are expressly preserved.

22 Section 3. Section 38-9D-3 of the Code of Alabama 23 1975, is amended to read as follows:

24 "§38-9D-3.

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25 "There is created the Alabama Interagency Council
26 for the Prevention of Elder Abuse. The members of the council
27 shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

"(1) The chief executive officer, or his or her
 designee, of each of the following participating agencies and

7	inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic,
8	urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state.
9	"(3) The chief executive officers of state agencies
10	serving on the council shall serve ex officio.
11	"(4) The council shall meet at <del>least bi-monthly</del> <u>the</u>
12	call of the chair and the meetings shall be open to the
13	public.
14	"(5) No member of the council shall cast a vote on
15	any matter which would provide direct financial benefit to
16	that member or otherwise give the appearance of a conflict of
17	interest under state law.
18	"(6) The Commissioner of the Department of Senior
19	Services shall serve as the chair of the council."
20	Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the
21	recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
22	Sections 1, 2, and 3.
23	Section 5. Section 38-9D-7, Code of Alabama 1975,
24	subjecting the council to review under the Alabama Sunset Law,
25	is repealed.

Section 6. This act shall become effective
 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
 its otherwise becoming law.
