19	To propose a constitutional amendment to the
20	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to exempt the state from the
21	observance of daylight saving time.
22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. The following amendment to the
24	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
25	shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a
26	majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in

1	accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
2	of Alabama of 1901, as amended:
3	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
4	As authorized under Section 3 of the Uniform Time
5	Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. §206a(a)), commencing the January 1
6	following the ratification of this amendment, the State of
7	Alabama is exempt from daylight saving time.
8	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
9	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
10	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284
11	and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
12	Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
13	state.
14	Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
15	assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
16	amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
17	following description of the substance or subject matter of
18	the proposed constitutional amendment:
19	"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
20	Alabama of 1901, to exempt the State of Alabama from daylight
21	saving time.
22	"Proposed by Act"
23	This description shall be followed by the following
24	language:

"Yes () No ()."
