8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would authorize a person who  
9 applies for or renews a driver's license, vessel  
10 license, or nondriver identification card to  
11 provide emergency contact information to the  
12 Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency.

15 TO BE ENTITLED  
16 AN ACT

18 Relating to driver's licenses and similar licenses  
19 or cards issued by the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency;  
20 to authorize a person who applies for a driver's license or  
21 similar license or card or the renewal of a license or card to  
22 provide emergency contact information to the Alabama State Law  
23 Enforcement Agency.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. (a) January 1 following the effective  
26 date of this act, each person who applies for a new driver's  
27 license, nondriver identification card, or vessel license, or

1 a learner's license or permit, or the renewal of any of the  
2 above licenses, cards, or permits, may provide the Alabama  
3 State Law Enforcement Agency with the name and contact  
4 information for the contact of a person in the event of an  
5 emergency. The emergency contact information provided in this  
6 section shall be stored in the records of the agency and made  
7 available to law enforcement personnel for contact in the  
8 event law enforcement deems contact is in the best interest of  
9 the licensee or card holder.

10 (b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may  
11 make rules necessary to carry out this act.

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
13 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
