BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$14,085,735 from the Education Trust Fund to the State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020. Of this appropriation, \$9,835,735 shall be expended for expansion of the science of reading training in support of initial implementations of the Literacy Act; \$2,700,000 shall be expended for additional regional math coaches and trainers to expand early mathematics improvement efforts and AMSTI, NUMBERS, and OGAP training opportunities; \$250,000 shall be expended to be paired with existing resources of the

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1	Department to continue the provision of one school safety
2	liaison per ALEA region to assist schools across the state;
3	\$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing campaign for
4	teachers; and \$300,000 shall be expended for teacher and
5	parent online teaching assistance grants.

Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$501,943 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Community College System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for Wetlab relocation and renovation.

Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to assist with the expansion of the Lockheed Martin Corporation training facility.

Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$400,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Alabama State

Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$144,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Fire College for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for one-time expenses for an audio/visual presentation system.

Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$6,878,778 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to assist in the construction and expansion of regional centers.

Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of South Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for one-time expenses for Children and Women's Learning Hospital expansion.

Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$2,170,265 from the Education Trust Fund to the Education Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 to be allocated in accordance with Section 29-9-4, Code of Alabama 1975.

1	Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
2	heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
3	\$50,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama
4	Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending
5	September 30, 2020.

Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$2,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of Early Childhood Education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$2,500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Supercomputer Authority for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for cybersecurity and IT support for K-12 schools in consultation with ALETS, of which \$1,000,000 shall be expended for professional development for all education employees in the form of software-based cybersecurity training focused on improving digital security.

Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Miles College for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020

Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated

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Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$35,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Wallace Community College-Selma for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for Excellence in Education to Employment Pipeline.

Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$280,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Athens State University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for virtual lab kits and student virtual interfaces and cloud delivery expenses.

Section 17. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$175,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Troy University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 for the Sign Language Interpretive Center.

Section 18. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$240,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Commission on Higher Education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, of which \$120,000 shall be for the City of Decatur and \$120,000 shall be for Marengo County to establish the Best and Brightest STEM Pilot Program for the purpose of

paying the student loan debt of recent STEM graduates that relocate to the City of Decatur and Marengo County. Applicants must have a STEM degree from an Alabama four-year institution of higher education and cannot be a resident of the subject county at the time of application. The duration of the pilot program shall be no more than five years and the amount available per graduate shall be \$3,000 annually.

Section 19. All funds appropriated in this act not expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 shall not revert but shall be carried forward for the purpose appropriated.

Section 20. The appropriation made within the Fine Arts Program of the Alabama State Council on the Arts in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 is amended to read as follows: "Of the above appropriation, \$875,000 shall be expended for the Alabama Center for the Arts, of which \$75,000 shall be expended for Urban Art; \$75,000 shall be expended for the Arts Hall of Fame; and \$200,000 shall be expended for the Alabama Center for the Arts Foundation."

Section 21. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any of the appropriation made in Section 3B of Act 2019-403 to the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and Engineering which remains unexpended on September 30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the school in the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

1	Section 22. Notwithstanding any other provision of
2	law to the contrary, any funds appropriated in Section 3A of
3	Act 2019-403 to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts
4	for the evaluation and reorganization study of the State
5	Department of Education which remains unexpended on September
6	30, 2020, shall be reappropriated to the Department in the
7	fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020.

Section 23. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 29-9-6, Code of Alabama 1975, during the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, temporary transfers from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the Education Trust Fund to alleviate cash flow problems shall be repaid within 180 days following the date the funds are transferred. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 29-9-5(b), amounts withdrawn prior to January 1, 2020 shall be repaid within four years.

Section 24. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming law.
