BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, an athletic organization is a high school athletic organization operating in the state that receives public funds in any form, whose member institutions make use of public facilities, and whose employees may participate in the Retirement Systems of Alabama.

- (b) Commencing on the effective date of the act adding this subsection, no rules relating to student participation eligibility may be enforced, amended, or adopted by an athletic organization without prior written approval of the State Board of Education. The State Board of Education shall develop a process for reviewing student participation eligibility rules existing on the effective date of the act adding this subsection and any new or amendatory rules proposed by the athletic organization.
- (c) Not later than January 1, 2020, at least 25 percent of the membership of the governing body of an athletic organization shall consist of individuals appointed by the
