6	other person shall be necessary.
7	"(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), an
8	unemancipated minor may not give consent to the administration
9	of vaccinations for himself or herself without consent of a
10	parent or legal guardian."
11	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12	first day of the third month following its passage and
13	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
