8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
9	Section 1. Section 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975,
10	is amended to read as follows:
11	"§11-42-21.
12	" <u>(a)</u> Whenever all of the owners of property located
13	and contained within an area contiguous to the corporate
14	limits of any incorporated municipality located in the state
15	<del>of Alabama</del> and <del>such</del> <u>the</u> property does not lie within the
16	corporate limits or police jurisdiction of any other
17	municipality, shall sign and file a written petition with the
18	city clerk of <del>such</del> <u>the</u> municipality requesting that <del>such</del> <u>the</u>
19	property <del>or territory</del> be annexed to the <del>said</del> municipality, and
20	the governing body of <del>such</del> <u>the</u> municipality adopts an
21	ordinance assenting to the annexation of <del>said</del> <u>the</u> property to
22	such <u>the</u> municipality, the corporate limits of <del>said</del> <u>the</u>
23	municipality shall be extended and rearranged so as to embrace
24	and include <del>such</del> the property, and <del>such</del> the property <del>or</del>
25	<del>territory</del> shall become a part of the corporate area of <del>such</del>

1 <u>the</u> municipality upon the date of <u>the</u> publication of said <u>the</u> 2 ordinance.

"(b)(1) It is provided further, that in In the event 3 any such incorporated municipality's police jurisdiction 4 5 overlaps with the police jurisdiction of one or more other 6 incorporated municipalities, the governing body of each such 7 any one of the incorporated municipality municipalities may 8 exercise the authority of this article, in such the 9 overlapping portions of their police jurisdiction, to a 10 boundary which is equidistant from the respective corporate 11 limits of each of such the incorporated municipalities which 12 have overlapping police jurisdictions.

"(2) , and provided further, If all of the owners of 13 14 property located and contained within such the area to be 15 annexed sign and file a written petition with the city clerk 16 of the incorporated municipality requesting that the property 17 be annexed to the incorporated municipality, and such the 18 property is contiguous to the corporate limits of such an the incorporated municipality, shall sign and file a written 19 20 petition with the city clerk of such incorporated municipality 21 requesting that such property be annexed to said incorporated 22 municipality and the governing body of such the incorporated 23 municipality adopts an ordinance assenting to the annexation 24 of said the property to such the municipality, the corporate 25 limits of said the municipality shall be extended and

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1 rearranged so as to embrace and include such the property and 2 such the property or territory shall become part of the corporate area of such the municipality upon the date of the 3 publication of said the ordinance. 4 5 "(c) If an incorporated municipality intends to 6 exercise its rights pursuant to subsection (b), but would have to perform more than one annexation pursuant to the 7 8 equidistant rule provided by subsection (b) to acquire the 9 entire parcel of property it intends to annex, the 10 incorporated municipality may request that all of the 11 municipalities whose police jurisdictions overlap assent to the annexation by adoption of a resolution of the governing 12 13 body of each of the municipalities, and if the governing body 14 of the annexing municipality adopts an ordinance assenting to 15 the annexation of the property to the municipality, then the 16 corporate limits of the municipality shall be extended and 17 rearranged so as to embrace and include the property, and the 18 property shall become a part of the corporate area of the 19 municipality upon the date of the publication of the 20 ordinance.

21 "(d) The petition required by this section shall
22 contain an accurate description of the property or territory
23 proposed to be annexed together with a map of the said
24 territory property showing its relationship to the corporate
25 limits of the municipality to which said the property is

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proposed to be annexed and the signatures of all <u>of</u> the owners of the property <del>or territory</del> described. It shall be the duty of the governing body to file a description of the property <del>or</del> <del>territory</del> annexed in the office of the judge of probate of the county in which the municipality is located."

6 Section 2. This act shall become immediately 7 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 8 otherwise becoming law.
