To amend Section 36-21-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the subsistence pay of certain law enforcement officers, to define a work day as working four or more hours within a consecutive 24-hour period of time.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 36-21-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"(a) (1) Any law enforcement officer of the State of Alabama who is employed by the Department of Public Safety
