8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a resident of Alabama
9 who is age 65 years or older is exempt from
10 obtaining a license to fish and a license to hunt.

11 This bill would provide that a nonresident
12 person who is age 65 years or older and who is
13 retired from the Armed Forces of the United States
14 would be exempt from obtaining a license to fish
15 and a license to hunt provided that the nonresident
16 has on his or her person a military identification
17 card to prove retired status and a driver's license
18 or other government issued identification card to
19 prove age.

22 TO BE ENTITLED
23 AN ACT

25 To provide that certain nonresident retired military
26 persons who are age 65 years or older are exempt from
27 obtaining a license to fish or hunt.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. A nonresident of this state who is
3 retired from the Armed Forces of the United States and who is
4 age 65 years or older shall be exempt from the requirement of
5 procuring a fishing license or a hunting license provided that
6 the nonresident has on his or her person a government issued
7 retired military identification card to prove retired status
8 and a driver's license or other government issued
9 identification card to prove age.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
11 first day of the third month following its passage and
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
