Section 1. A nonresident of this state who is retired form the Armed Forces of the United States and who is age 65 years or older shall be exempt from the requirement of procuring a fishing license or a hunting license provided that the nonresident has on his or her person a government issued retired military identification card to prove retired status and a driver's license or other government issued identification card to prove age.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
