## HB224 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2  
3 Relating to Cullman County; to provide for the  
4 creation, funding, and operation of the Cullman County  
5 Legislative Delegation Fund; to provide for the distribution  
6 of the net proceeds of the state beer tax payable to Cullman  
7 County and the additional three percent of TVA in-lieu-of  
8 taxes payments received by Cullman County; to abolish the  
9 Cullman County Community Development Commission; and to repeal  
10 Section 45-22-90, Code of Alabama 1975.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) The Cullman County Commission shall  
13 create the Cullman County Legislative Delegation Fund.

14 (b) The fund shall be comprised of the following monies  
15 received by the county:

16 (1) The additional three percent of TVA  
17 in-lieu-of-taxes payments received pursuant to Section  
18 40-28-2, Code of Alabama 1975.

19 (2) Any other monies provided for by law.

20 (b) The commission shall immediately pay amounts from  
21 the fund as the Cullman County Legislative Delegation may  
22 request.

23 (c) The legislative delegation shall expend the monies  
24 on allowable public purposes at the discretion and direction  
25 of the legislative delegation.

26 (d) All decisions concerning the Cullman County  
27 Legislative Delegation Fund shall be made by resolutions  
28 adopted by the members of the Cullman County Legislative

29 Delegation.

30 (e) Any funds allocated but not spent at the end of the  
31 fiscal year shall not be applied for any other purpose, but  
32 shall be carried forward and shall remain available year to  
33 year for expenditure as provided in this section.

34 (f) The revenue and expenditures of the legislative  
35 office shall be audited on an annual basis.

36 Section 2. The net proceeds of the state beer tax  
37 payable to Cullman County pursuant to Section 28-3-184, Code  
38 of Alabama 1975, shall be distributed as follows:

39 (1) Fifty percent to the Cullman County Legislative  
40 Delegation Fund.

41 (2) Fifty percent to the municipalities in Cullman  
42 County to be divided pro-rata based on the population of each  
43 municipality to be used at the discretion of the governing  
44 body receiving the funds.

45 Section 3. (a) The Cullman County Community Development  
46 Commission is abolished.

47 (b) (1) The Community Development Fund within the  
48 Cullman County Treasury is abolished.

49 (2) Any remaining monies in the Community Development  
50 Fund shall be transferred to the Cullman County Legislative  
51 Delegation Fund.

52 Section 4. Section 45-22-90, Code of Alabama 1975,  
53 establishing the Cullman County Community Development  
54 Commission, is repealed.

55 Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately  
56 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
