8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the driver of a motor 9 vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury 10 to or death of any person or damage to a motor 11 vehicle is required to immediately stop the vehicle 12 and remain at the scene of the accident or as close 13 as possible.

This bill would authorize the driver of a 14 15 vehicle to move a motor vehicle involved in an 16 accident from the roadway when no apparent serious 17 physical injury or death has occurred and would 18 authorize employees of the Department of Transportation and the Alabama Law Enforcement 19 20 Agency to require and assist in moving a disabled 21 vehicle involved in an accident from the roadway on 22 the state highway system.

23The bill would provide immunity to the24departments for actions under the bill.

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3	To amend Section 32-10-1, Code of Alabama 1975,

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 32-10-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

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"§32-10-1.

"(a) The driver of any motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or the death of any person, or in damage to a motor vehicle or other vehicle which is driven or attended by any person, shall immediately stop such vehicle at the scene of such accident or as close thereto as possible and shall then forthwith return to and in every event shall remain at the scene of the accident until he or she has

1	fulfilled the requirements of Section 32-10-3. Every such stop
2	shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is
3	necessary. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the accident does
4	not involve any apparent injury or the death of a person, the
5	driver may immediately move the vehicle from the roadway to
6	the shoulder, emergency lane, median, or other location close
7	to the accident site if the vehicle is drivable and can be
8	safely moved from the roadway and shall forthwith return to or
9	remain at or as close to the scene of the accident as safely
10	possible.
11	"(b) Employees of the Alabama Department of
12	Transportation or the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency may move
13	a vehicle, require a vehicle to be moved, or assist in the
14	moving of a vehicle from a highway under the jurisdiction of
15	the Department of Transportation if the vehicle is disabled as
16	a result of an accident, the disabled vehicle creates a
17	traffic hazard or is obstructing traffic, and the vehicle may
18	be safely moved or movement of the vehicle will result in the
19	improved safety or convenience of travel on the road. A
20	disabled vehicle may also be moved by the driver of the
21	vehicle or with the assistance of a towing or recovery
22	vehicle. A disabled vehicle involved in an accident with
23	injury to or death of any person may not be moved until
24	directed by a law enforcement officer.
25	"(c) This section does not relieve a driver from
26	complying with any other duties imposed in this chapter.

1	"(d) The Department of Transportation and the
2	Alabama Law Enforcement Agency shall not be liable for damages
3	caused by moving a vehicle pursuant to this section.
4	"(e) Section 36-1-12 shall apply to employees of the
5	Department of Transportation and the Alabama Law Enforcement
6	Agency relating to any claim resulting from the exercise of
7	authority under this section.
8	" (b)<u>(f)</u> The director shall revoke the driver's
9	license of a person convicted under this section."
10	Section 2. This act shall become effective
11	immediately following its passage and approval by the
12	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
