8	To amend Section 41-9-870, Code of Alabama 1975,
9	relating to the Alabama Peace Officers Hall of Fame; to
10	provide further for membership requirements, terms of office,
11	diversity of membership, and selection of a chair each two

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 41-9-870 of the Code of Alabama
15	1975, is amended to read as follows:
16	"§41-9-870.
17	" <u>(a)</u> The Alabama Peace Officers' Hall of Fame Board
18	is hereby created and established. The board shall be composed
19	of seven law enforcement officers , no two of whom shall be
20	from the same congressional district, elected for a term of
21	four years by the board itself. Board members shall be
22	prohibited from serving consecutive terms. Any board member
23	serving on the effective date of the act adding this language
24	shall serve a term of four years commencing from that date,
25	and thereafter, all board members shall be appointed as herein
26	provided and shall serve a term of office of four years. The
27	board shall annually <u>Each two years the board shall</u> elect one

1 of the its members to serve as chairman chair. The initial 2 board members shall be appointed as follows, viz: The member from Congressional District No. 1 One member shall be 3 4 appointed by from the Alabama Peace Officers' Association; the member from Congressional District No. 2 one member shall be 5 appointed by from the Alabama Sheriffs' Association; the 6 7 member from Congressional District No. 3 one member shall be appointed by from the Fraternal Order of Police; the member 8 9 from Congressional District No. 4 one member shall be 10 appointed by from the Alabama League of Municipalities; the member from Congressional District No. 5 one member shall be 11 12 appointed by from the Alabama Association of County 13 Commissioners; the member from Congressional District No. 6 14 one member shall be appointed by the Alabama Association of Chiefs of Police, and the member from Congressional District 15 No. 7 one member shall be appointed by from the Alabama State 16 17 Troopers Association. Members of the board shall not be compensated for their services. The board shall meet annually 18 at the office of the Alabama Peace Officers' Association, and 19 20 or at such other times and places as its rules and bylaws may 21 prescribe. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum 22 for the transaction of business.

23 "(b) The membership of the board shall be inclusive
24 and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and
25 economic diversity of the state."

Section 2. This act shall become effective
 immediately following its passage and approval by the
 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
