1 of Conservation and Natural Resources heretofore promulgated
2 shall continue in effect until repealed or amended by the
3 commission. Unless otherwise provided by law, a violation of
4 any rule adopted by the commission pertaining to the conduct
5 of persons on land designated as a state forest shall be a
6 Class C misdemeanor. violation. No additional violation may be
7 promulgated by this commission without legislative enactment.

8 "(b) For purposes of this section, the term "state
9 forest" means land owned, leased, or otherwise held by the
10 commission and designated by the commission as a state
11 forest."

12 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its
13 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
14 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
15 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
16 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
17 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
18 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
19 existing crime.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
