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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama
4 1975, those general and permanent laws of the state enacted
5 during the 2012 Regular Session and 2012 First Special Session
6 as contained in the 2012 Cumulative Supplement to certain
7 volumes of the code and 2012 Replacement Volumes 11, 11A, 13,
8 and 20; to initially adopt and incorporate into the Code of
9 Alabama 1975, 2012 Volume 22G (Local Laws Etowah - Geneva
10 Counties) and to adopt and incorporate into the Code of
11 Alabama 1975, 2012 Cumulative Supplements to local law
12 volumes; to make certain corrections in certain volumes of the
13 cumulative supplement; to specify that this adoption and
14 incorporation constitute a continuous systematic codification
15 of the entire Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law
16 that adopts a code; to declare that the Code Publisher has
17 certified it has discharged its duties regarding the
18 replacement volumes; to expressly provide that this act does
19 not affect any other 2013 session statutes; and to specify the
20 duties of the Secretary of State regarding the custody of
21 these cumulative supplements, replacement volumes, and initial
22 volume.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. (a) Those general and permanent laws of
25 the state enacted during the 2012 Regular Session and the 2012

1 First Special Session as contained in the 2012 Cumulative
2 Supplements to Volumes 3 to 10, inclusive, Volumes 12 and 12A,
3 Volumes 13A to 19A, inclusive, and Volumes 21 to 22A,
4 inclusive, and the 2012 Replacement Volumes 11, 11A, 13, and
5 20 and the additions and deletions made by the Code
6 Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published
7 by West Group, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the
8 2012 Cumulative Supplement and 2012 Replacement Volumes are
9 identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of
10 Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of the volumes
11 of the cumulative supplement and upon the first inside page
12 and the last inside page of the replacement volume, are
13 adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

14 (b) The following correction is made to the 2012
15 Cumulative Supplements:

16 Section 34-17-21, 2012 Cumulative Supplement to
17 Volume 18, page 127. To correct a manifest clerical error
18 which resulted in the inadvertent deletion of language from
19 this section, restore subdivision (3) to read as follows:

20 "(3) Is a citizen of the United States or, if not a
21 citizen of the United States, is a person who is legally
22 present in the United States with appropriate documentation
23 from the federal government."

24 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the
25 state previously enacted and contained in initial 2012 Volume

1 22G (Local Laws Etowah - Geneva Counties) and the local and
2 permanent laws pertaining to various counties enacted during
3 the 2012 Regular Session and the 2012 First Special Session as
4 contained in the 2012 Cumulative Supplement to Volumes 22B,
5 22C, 22D, 22E, and 22F and the additions and deletions made by
6 the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and
7 published by West Group, as the Code Publisher, which volumes
8 of the 2012 Cumulative Supplement are identified and
9 authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed
10 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the
11 cumulative supplement, are adopted and incorporated into the
12 Code of Alabama 1975.

13 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the
14 supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act
15 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the
16 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the
17 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
18 as amended. This act is a law that adopts a code for the
19 purposes of Section 45 of the Official Recompilation of the
20 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

21 Section 4. It is declared that West Group, as the
22 Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its
23 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2012
24 Replacement Volumes 11, 11A, 13, and 20 of the Code of Alabama
25 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes

1 with the material contained in the cumulative supplement
2 without making substantive changes, but making, under the
3 supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code
4 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may
5 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of
6 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and
7 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and
8 misspellings.

9 Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not
10 repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any
11 statute enacted into law during any 2013 session of the
12 Legislature.

13 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act,
14 the duly authenticated volumes of the 2012 Cumulative
15 Supplements and the 2012 Replacement Volumes shall be
16 transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the
17 volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in that
18 office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement volumes
19 shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary of
20 State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper
21 certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or
22 parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for
23 similar services.

1 Section 7. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
