1 "(2) ~~He, being~~ Being 19 years old or older, subjects
2 another person to sexual contact who is less than 16 years
3 old, but more than 12 years old.

4 "(b) Sexual abuse in second degree is a Class A
5 misdemeanor, except ~~that~~ as provided in subsection (c), and or
6 if a person commits a second or subsequent offense of sexual
7 abuse in the second degree within one year of another sexual
8 offense, the offense is a Class C felony.

9 "(c) If a person violates subdivision (a)(2), and he
10 or she is at least 15 years older than the victim, the offense
11 shall be a Class C felony."

12 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its
13 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
14 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
15 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
16 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
17 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
18 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
19 existing crime.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
