4	SYNOPSIS:
5	The Constitution of Alabama of 2022, provides
6	that it is the public policy of this state to recognize
7	and support the sanctity of unborn life, the rights of
8	unborn children, including the right to life.
9	This bill would propose an amendment to the
10	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide that an
11	extrauterine embryo is not an "unborn life" or "unborn
12	child."

15	A BILL
16	TO BE ENTITLED
17	AN ACT

19	Proposing an amendment to Section 36.06 of the
20	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to unborn children.
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
23	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
24	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
25	"Section 36.06
26	(a) This state acknowledges, declares, and affirms that
27	it is the public policy of this state to recognize and support
28	the sanctity of unborn life and the rights of unborn children,



29 including the right to life.

30 (b) This state further acknowledges, declares, and 31 affirms that it is the public policy of this state to ensure 32 the protection of the rights of the unborn child in all 33 manners and measures lawful and appropriate. 34 (c) Nothing in this constitution secures or protects a 35 right to abortion or requires the funding of an abortion. 36 (d) For the purpose of this section, an extrauterine 37 embryo is not an "unborn life" or "unborn child."" Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the 38 39 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 40 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: 41 42 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation 43 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 44 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize 45 46 language; and translate effective dates. 47 END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT 48 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 49 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 50 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this

51 state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot 52 number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the 53 election ballot and shall set forth the following description 54 of the substance or subject matter of the proposed

55 constitutional amendment:

of 2022, to provide that an extrauterine embryo is not an 57 "unborn life" or "unborn child." 58 Proposed by Act ____." 59 60 This description shall be followed by the following 61 language: 62 "Yes() No()." Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as 63 64 a part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon. 65 66
