4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Prior to 2017, in capital murder cases, the jury
6	would provide an advisory verdict to the judge
7	regarding the defendant's sentence. The jury's advisory
8	sentence was not binding upon the court; however, the
9	judge was required to give it consideration.
10	This bill would provide that a defendant may be
11	resentenced if a judge sentenced him or her to a
12	sentence other than the jury's advisory sentence.
13	This bill would repeal the existing code section
14	relating to resentencing for certain defendants
15	sentenced for capital murder.
16	This bill would also make nonsubstantive,
17	technical revisions to update the existing code
18	language to current style.

25	Relating to sentencing; to add Section 13A-5-46.1 to
26	the Code of Alabama 1975, to provide for resentencing for
27	certain defendants sentenced for capital murder; to repeal
28	Section 13A-5-47.1, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to

29	resentencing for certain defendants; and to make
30	nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the existing
31	code language to current style.
32	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
33	Section 1. Section 13A-5-46.1 is added to the Code of
34	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
35	(a) Notwithstanding Section 13A-5-57, a defendant
36	sentenced prior to June 1, 2024, shall be resentenced pursuant
37	to Section 13A-5-46, upon petition to the sentencing court.
38	(b) The petition shall be on a form and filed in the
39	manner prescribed by the Administrative Office of Courts.
40	Petitions shall be considered authorized motions for
41	modifications of sentence, assigned a unique identifier by the
42	Administrative Office of Courts, and shall not require payment
43	of a filing fee.
44	(c) The Administrative Office of Courts shall adopt
45	rules as are necessary to implement this section.
46	Section 2. Section 13A-5-47.1, Code of Alabama 1975,
47	relating to the application of sentencing of certain
48	defendants convicted of capital murder, is repealed.
49	Section 3. This act shall become effective June 1,
50	2024.
