25	To propose an amendment to the Constitution of

percent of the net proceeds shall be distributed equally between the Alabama Firefighters' Annuity and Benefit Fund and the Alabama Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, and to provide that the remaining proceeds be distributed to the State General Fund.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

(a) After December 31, 2012, an additional state ad
valorem tax shall be levied at the rate of one-half mill per
annum on the assessed value of the taxable property within the
state.

(b) The first 20 percent of the net proceeds of the
tax levied by subsection (a) shall be distributed evenly
between the Alabama Firefighters' Annuity and Benefit Fund and
the Alabama Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund.

(c) The tax proceeds remaining after the
distribution made in subsection (b) shall be distributed to
the State General Fund.

25 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 26 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 27 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284

and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
 state.

4 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 5 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 6 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 7 following description of the substance or subject matter of 8 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 9 10 Alabama of 1901, to provide an additional one-half mill of ad valorem tax to take effect after December 31, 2012, for years 11 12 on taxable property in the state and distributing the first 20 13 percent of the net proceeds evenly between the Alabama 14 Firefighters' Annuity and Benefit Fund and the Alabama Peace 15 Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, with remaining amounts distributed to the State General Fund. 16

18 This description shall be followed by the following 19 language:

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"Yes () No ()."
