In addition, the maximum amount of funds from the sales tax for the administration of the Food Stamp Program that may be reverted by the Department of Human Resources to the Education Trust Fund shall be \$11,028,645 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010. Any such funds over this amount not utilized in the Food Stamp Program shall be
