22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. (a) For the purpose of this section "illegal
2 4	alien" means an individual not entitled to lawfully reside or
25	work in the United States.

26 (b) In all cases when it is shown that a criminal
27 defendant, who is an illegal alien, has been convicted of a

- 36 imprisonment for life or for any term of not more than 99
- years, but not less than 15 years.
