8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a local  
9 constitutional amendment relating to Shelby County  
10 to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages on  
11 Sunday under certain conditions.

13 A BILL  
14 TO BE ENTITLED  
15 AN ACT

17 To propose a local constitutional amendment relating  
18 to Shelby County to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages  
19 on Sunday under certain conditions.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. The following amendment to the  
22 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become  
23 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of  
24 this act are fulfilled:

25 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

26 In Shelby County, the sale and distribution of  
27 alcoholic beverages shall be legal after 12:00 p.m. on Sunday

1 by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic  
2 Beverage Control Board.

3 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
4 shall be held at the next countywide election in accordance  
5 with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now  
6 appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of  
7 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the  
8 election laws of this state.

9 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
10 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
11 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
12 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
13 the proposed constitutional amendment:

14 "Relating to Shelby County, proposing an amendment  
15 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the sale  
16 of alcoholic beverages on Sunday after 12:00 p.m. by properly  
17 licensed retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage  
18 Control Board.
