ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Baldwin County; to repeal Act 253 of the 1951 Regular Session (Acts 1951, p. 528), relating to the Barbers' Commission of Baldwin County; to abolish the Barbers' Commission of Baldwin County; and to provide that the practice of barbering in Baldwin County be regulated by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Upon the effective date of this act, the Barbers' Commission of Baldwin County is abolished. Any person subject to Act 253 of the 1951 Regular Session (Acts 1951, p. 528), establishing the Barbers' Commission of Baldwin County, shall instead be subject to the provisions of Chapter 7B of Title 13, Code of Alabama 1975, establishing the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering, except that any license issued by the Barbers' Commission of Baldwin County prior to the effective date of this act shall remain valid until its expiration date.

Section 2. Act 253 of the 1951 Regular Session (Acts 1951, p. 528), establishing the Barbers' Commission of Baldwin County, is repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
