To prohibit any person or other entity from imposing an accident response service fee for the investigation of a motor vehicle accident on an insurance company, the driver or owner of a motor vehicle, or any other person or entity.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. As used in this act, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- (1) ACCIDENT RESPONSE SERVICE FEE. A fee imposed for the response or investigation by a law enforcement officer or agency of a motor vehicle accident.
- (2) ENTITY. A governmental entity or agency or department of a governmental entity.
- of Public Safety, the police department of each incorporated city or municipality, the department of each sheriff of the state, including all deputies sheriff deputy sheriffs, the enforcement division of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, and the Public Service Commission, and each public agency in the state charged with the enforcement of any laws and the officers and employees of which have the power as such to make arrests. The term shall does not include rescue squads or volunteer fire departments.
