Relating to the Elevator Safety Review Board within the Department of Labor; to amend Section 25-13-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2010-597, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 1343), to further provide for the use of funds in the operational fund of the board for the operation of the department.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 25-13-6, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2010-597, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 1343), is amended to read as follows:

13 "\$25-13-6.

"(a) The board may consult with engineering 14 15 authorities and organizations concerned with standard safety 16 codes, rules, and regulations governing the operation, maintenance, servicing, construction, alteration, 17 18 installation, and inspection of elevators, dumbwaiters, 19 escalators, and the qualifications which are adequate, reasonable, and necessary for an elevator mechanic, 20 21 contractor, and inspector. Therefore, the board may recommend 22 the amendments of applicable legislation, when appropriate, to 23 legislators.

"(b) The board shall establish regulations for the equipment regulated by this chapter. The regulations shall

include the Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators, ASME A17.1; the Safety Code for Existing Elevators and Escalators, ASME A17.3; the Safety Standards for Platform Lifts and Stairway Chairlifts, ASME A18.1; Standard for the Qualification of Elevator Inspectors, ASME QEI-1; and Automated People Mover Standards, ASCE 21. The board shall adopt the latest editions of the standards within six months of their effective date. Any modifications to the standards that the administrator deems necessary shall be justified in writing by the board.

- "(c) The board may grant exceptions and variances from the literal requirements of applicable code and standards, regulations, or local legislation, or any combination of these, in cases where such variances would not jeopardize the public safety and welfare. The board may hear appeals, hold hearings, and decide upon appeals within 30 days of the appeal.
- "(d) The board shall establish fee schedules for licenses, permits, certificates, and inspections. The fees shall reflect the actual costs and expenses to conduct the duties as described in this chapter. All fees collected by the administrator pursuant to this chapter shall be remitted to the Elevator Safety Review Board Operational Fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the board for its operation and for the operation of the Department of Labor. Any funds

1	appropriated for the operation of the board that are not			
2	needed for current operations as determined by the director of			
3	the department and within the appropriation ceiling of the			
4	board may be used for operation of the department. All fees			
5	collected in the Elevator Safety Review Board Operational Fund			
6	above the appropriated amount shall be transferred to the			
7	State General Fund within one quarter after the end of each

9	In addition, the director of the department may			
10	transfer unused funds in the Elevator Safety Review Board			
11	Operational Fund to the State General Fund.			
12	"(e) The board shall be subject to the Alabama			
13	Sunset Law, Chapter 20, Title 41, as an enumerated agency as			
14	provided in Section 41-20-3, and shall have a termination date			
15	of October 1, 2005, and every four years thereafter, unless			
16	continued pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law."			
17	Section 2. This act shall become effective			
18	immediately following its passage and approval by the			
19	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
