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funds within the meaning of the amendment. However,

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. Section 9-13-10.2 is added to the Code of
22	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

24	(a)(1) The State Forestry Commission may adopt,
25	alter, amend, or repeal rules governing the preservation,
26	protection, and use of state forests and any other lands
27	owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by the commission.

1 (2) Any person who violates a rule adopted pursuant 2 to this act shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor and shall 3 be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50) nor more than five 4 hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense, and may be required 5 to pay all costs of the proceedings.

6 (3) When collected, all fines shall be paid to the 7 Office of the State Forester to be delivered to the State 8 Treasurer and placed in the Alabama Forestry Commission Fund.

9 (b) The State Forester and any employee of the State 10 Forestry Commission so designated by the State Forester shall 11 have and is vested with the authority to prefer charges and 12 issue a citation against a person for violating a rule adopted 13 pursuant to this act or for the violation of any other 14 provision of this article.

15 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 16 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further 17 18 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of 19 20 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 21 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an 22 existing crime.

23 Section 3. This act shall become effective 24 immediately following its passage and approval by the 25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
