## HB323 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Calhoun County; to amend Section 1 of Acts  
3 1978, No. 117 (Acts 1978, p. 1832), and to replace Section  
4 45-8-200.01, Code of Alabama 1975, as added by Acts 1965, No.  
5 154 (Acts 1965, p. 218), which act was repealed by Acts 1978,  
6 No. 117 (Acts 1978, p. 1832); and to further provide for the  
7 compensation of the license commissioner.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 1 of Acts 1978, No. 117 (Acts 1978,  
10 p. 1832), is amended to read as follows:

11 ~~"The license commissioner presently serving in Calhoun~~  
12 ~~County shall continue in that office until his successor is~~  
13 ~~elected, in the 1980 primary or general election, and assumes~~  
14 ~~office in January, 1981.~~ (a) Commencing with the election of  
15 the license commissioner in the 1980 election, the term of  
16 office shall be for six years from January<sub>7</sub> 1981<sub>7</sub> and shall be  
17 filled by the majority of the qualified electors voting  
18 ~~thereon~~ at the primary or general election held<sub>7</sub> in 1980<sub>7</sub> for  
19 county-wide offices which terms commence in 1981<sub>7</sub> and every  
20 six years thereafter.

21 (b) Notice of the election shall be given by the judge  
22 of probate, which ~~notice~~ shall be published once a week for  
23 three successive weeks before the day of the election.

24 (c) Candidates for the office shall qualify as other  
25 candidates for county office.

26 (d) The judge of probate shall certify the results of  
27 the election to the Secretary of State in the same manner as  
28 is required for all local or general elections.

29           (e) Beginning with the new term of office in January  
30 1981~~7~~, and thereafter, the commissioner of license shall  
31 receive an annual salary of twenty-two thousand five hundred  
32 thousand dollars (\$22,500). Such salary shall be paid from the  
33 county treasury in the same manner as other county officers'  
34 salaries are paid."

35           Section 2. (a) Effective July 1, 2024, the commissioner  
36 of licenses shall receive an additional expense allowance  
37 equal to 12.5 percent of the commissioner's salary on June 1,  
38 2024, payable in equal monthly installments from the general  
39 fund of the county. The expense allowance shall be in addition  
40 to all other compensation, expense allowances, or benefits  
41 granted to the commissioner.

42           (b) Beginning with the next term of office after July  
43 1, 2024, the commissioner of licenses shall receive an annual  
44 salary equal to 112.5 percent of the commissioner's salary on  
45 June 1, 2024, and the expense allowance in subsection (a)  
46 shall be void.

47           Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,  
48 2024.
